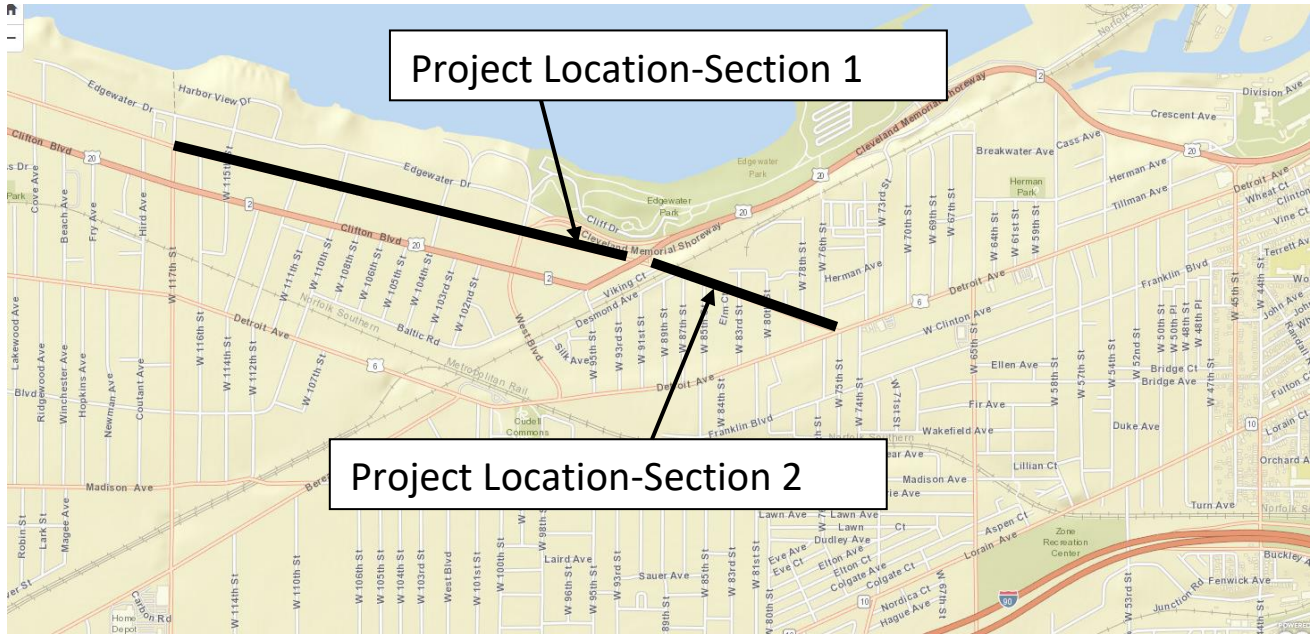

What: The purpose of this presentation is to provide information and receive feedback on plans for the upcoming Lake Avenue Rehabilitation Project. The proposed improvements on Lake Avenue from West 117th Street to Detroit Avenue include:

- Mill and resurface roadway pavement and repair pavement base based on condition.
- Repair based on condition of concrete drive aprons and curbs along Lake Avenue.
- Repair of sidewalks to replace damaged slabs and trip hazards.
- Install ADA compliant curb ramps at intersections.
- Reconstruct drainage facilities including catch basins.
- Install pedestrian refuge islands at West 110th Street, along Lake Avenue from Clifton Boulevard to Viking Court and at West 78th Street. These islands will be landscaped with native and drought tolerant plantings.
- Install enhanced crosswalks with Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB's) and new pedestrian refuge islands at West 78th Street and West 85th Street to facilitate pedestrians crossing Lake Avenue.
- Provide bike lanes in both directions from Clifton Avenue to Detroit Avenue.
- Parking lanes will remain along the corridor in available areas.

Estimated Cost: \$3,622,000
Funding Source: Federal, City and Utility funds
