CUY LAKE AVENUE RESURFACING

Lake Ave. from West 117th St. Detroit Ave.

Expect additional traffic notices as improvements continue

CLEVELAND – On July 19, 2021, the City of Cleveland will begin the Lake Avenue Resurfacing Project (West 117th Street to Detroit Avenue).

Maintenance of traffic will be as follows:

- One-way, westbound traffic will be maintained on the Lake Avenue between West 117th Street and West Boulevard.
 - Eastbound motorists will be detoured south on W. 117th Street, east on Clifton and north on West Boulevard.
 - Estimated timeframe is July 19, 2021 to September 2021
 - On-Street Parking is maintained on one side of the street
- One-way, eastbound traffic will be maintained on Lake Avenue between West Boulevard and Clifton Road.
 - Westbound motorists will be detoured west on Clifton and north on West Boulevard.
 - Estimated timeframe is September 2021 to November 2021
 - On-Street Parking is maintained on one side of the street
- Two-way traffic will be maintained on Lake Avenue between Clifton Road and Detroit Avenue.
 - Estimated timeframe is September 2021 to November 2021
 - NO On-Street Parking is maintained during construction

Electronic message boards will be placed to inform the public of the impending construction work.

Lake Avenue construction is being administered by the Ohio Department of Transportation. Improvements include:

- Milling and asphalt resurfacing
- Full depth and partial depth pavement repairs
- Utility adjustments
- Curb, drive apron and walk replacements as needed
- Replacement of curb ramps to bring them into compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act
- Raised medians will be placed at W. 110th Street and W. 78th Street intersections, and east of Clifton to Viking Ct
- Updated signing and pavement markings including dedicated parking.

Construction is scheduled to be completed in Fall 2021.
